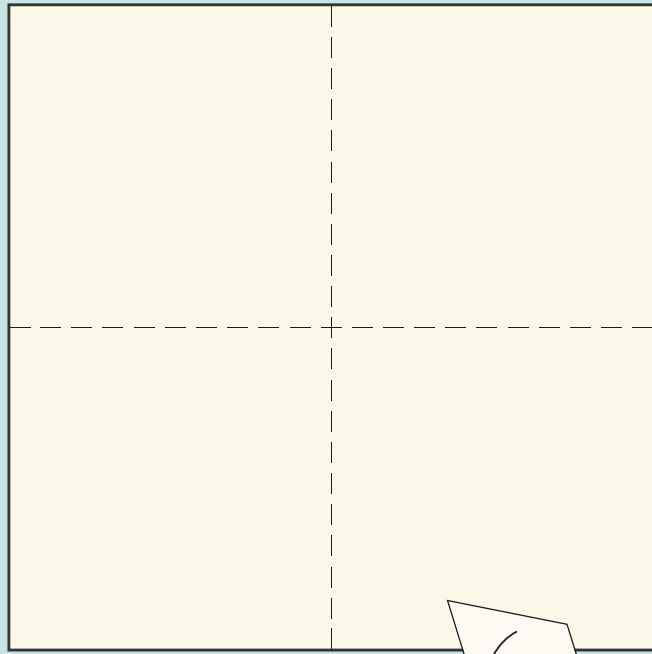




Origami Crane

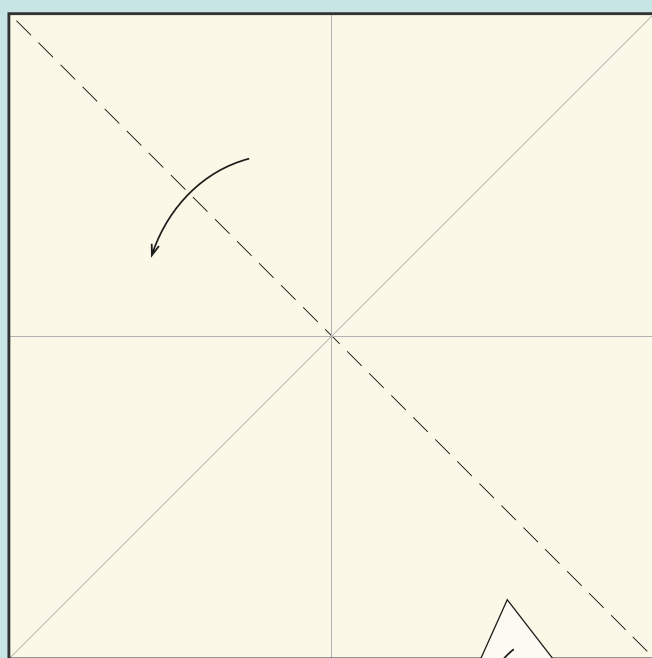
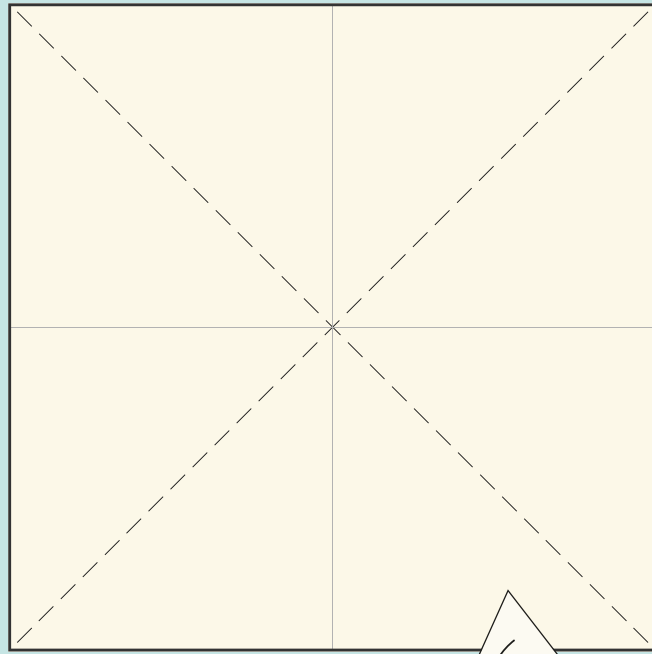
Paper quality 65-80 gramme, create square 10 cm



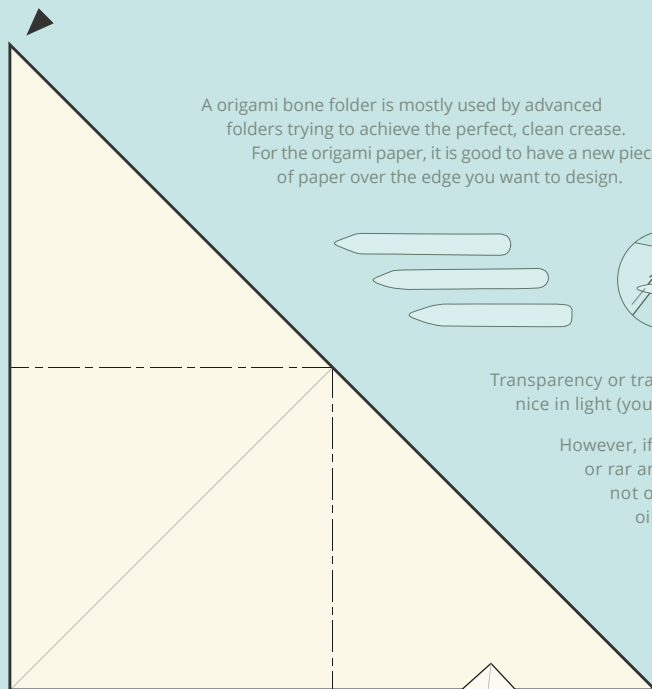
1. Take time, try very exact to fold and unfold.



Turn the paper...

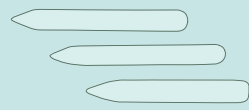


2. Fold diagonal again.

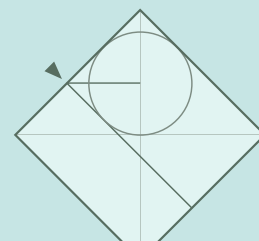


3. The corners to the inside...

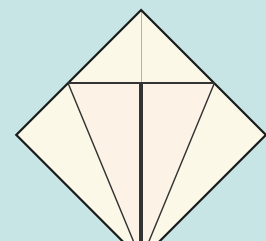
A origami bone folder is mostly used by advanced folders trying to achieve the perfect, clean crease. For the origami paper, it is good to have a new piece of paper over the edge you want to design.



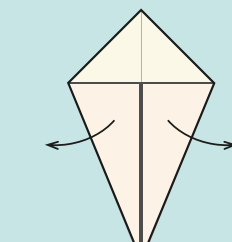
Transparency or translucent paper looks pretty nice in light (you can see in my photos).
However, if you will be working with washi or rar and expensive paper, it can help you not only with creases, but prevent dirt or oil from transferring from your fingertips to the paper.



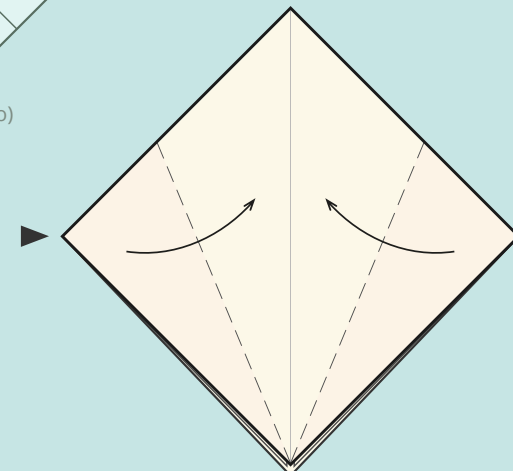
